## Bylaws Article I – Duties Of Officers Section 1

### Current

 The PRESIDENT shall reside at all **Board and Executive Committee** meetings. He/ She shall appoint all standing committees and any ad hoc committees that may be required from time to time. He/ She shall supervise the activities of all appointed committees by serving as an ex-official member of each. He/ She shall attend the IAABO Spring Meeting.

#### New

 The PRESIDENT shall reside at all **Board and Executive Committee** meetings. He/ She shall appoint all standing committees and any ad hoc committees that may be required from time to time. He/ She shall supervise the activities of all appointed committees by serving as an ex-official member of each. He/ She shall attend the IAABO Annual Meeting.

# Bylaws Article IV – Discipline of Members Section 3

### Current

Penalties which may be administered by the Executive Committee include:

Suspension: (For one year or permanent)

Probation: (not in good standing/Unable to Officiate through Jan. 15th)

Fine: (1st Offense - one Varsity game fee, 2nd Offense - five Varsity Game fees) (Amended Nov. 2019)

Warning: (which will be kept in a confidential file by the Secretary for three years and then destroyed)

A record of penalties (other than Warnings) will be kept indefinitely by the Secretary.

### New

Penalties which may be administered by the Executive Board include:

Warning: This action shall be the first step of discipline and shall be applied to any act which does not meet the intent of a more significant complaint. Any warning will be kept in a confidential file by the Secretary for a period of one year and then destroyed.

Fine: A member may be fined a minimum of one Varsity game fee to a maximum of five Varsity game fees.

Suspension: The beginning date, ending date and overall length of any suspension shall not exceed one year.

Expulsion: An expelled member shall be defined as one who loses all rights and privileges of the association for more than one year.

The penalties stated above will have a letter written to the offending member outlining the day and date by which the complaint was finalized. It shall state the Constitution, Policy or BY-LAW which has been violated. A record of penalties (other than Warnings) will be kept indefinitely by the Secretary.

# Bylaws Article IV - Discipline of Members Section 4

### Current

Suspended Members must appear before the Executive Committee of the Board and show cause before being reinstated

#### New

An Expelled Member must appear before the Executive Board and show cause before reinstatement may be considered

An Expelled Member desiring reinstatement to membership in the Association shall successfully complete all requirements of a new cadet. No waiver or optional examination procedures are permitted.
